Walking in Central Sweden gives you the opportunity to enjoy the wilderness and its inhabitants, not too far away from civilization. An hour's drive takes you from a city of 150,000 inhabitants - and all related facilities - to the peace of the wilderness, where you might just come face to face with a moose. Here, you can walk across agricultural land to a bird sanctuary and walk from a charming fishing village along a solitary coast to a private beach. Discover the small coastal islands, or visit the dense forests where Finnish nomads settled in the 17th century. Walk in the footsteps of silver and iron seekers or discover the natural habitat of the Scandinavian bear by foot. Explore the green heart of the city of Gävle. Walk past crystal clear lakes and rivers, or even take a dip.

Walking in Central Sweden provides a combination of everything beautiful that Sweden has to offer. A blend of nature and culture, of quiet and 'busy', of city and wilderness, of north and south, from big Swedish game to a visit to a cultural and industrial heritage that has been added to the UNESCO World Heritage list.
